

Item submission form

1. Partner's information

In the Followmybid lexicon, a «partner» is a business or an individual who donates an item to be auctioned off during an auction.

Full name or business name

If more than one individual is donating a single item, please enter all partners' first and last names separated by a comma (e.g. John Tremblay, Jane Roy, Alice Gagnon). If you are submitting an item on behalf of a business, please only include the business name (e.g. Followmybid).

Photo

The auction organizer can add a photo of the partners to the item information sheet when creating the «Partners» section.

You can attach a photo of each partner with your message when submitting this form by email.

2. Item information

Item name

Item description

Describe the item you are auctioning. You can include features such as brand, size, or any other relevant information. If the item is an activity, include as much detail as possible to inform and increase participants' interest in this activity.

Value

Here, specify the market or real value of the item. Check the «Incalculable» box if it is impossible to accurately determine the value of an item when this item's worth is subjective or arbitrary.
